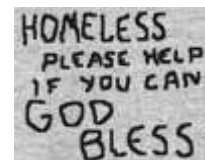

# *Meditation*

## *God's Providential Care*

*God has a special love for every human person and a special plan for each of us. Often enough, God's plan is not what we would expect. Look at the lives of great people like Pope John Paul II or Blessed Teresa of Calcutta. During World War II, Karol Wojtyla (Pope John Paul II) was a laborer and an actor, but led by God, he entered an underground seminary. Born in Albania, Blessed Teresa found herself seeking out the dying in the gutters of Calcutta. Have the lives of these two unfolded according to their original plans? Surely not. If and when we accept God's love in our lives, he can ask surprising and sometimes challenging things of us.*

*Why do so many of us tend to brush aside God's plan for us in our lives? It seems to be because we find it hard to imagine how he can be so loving to us, especially in awkward surroundings. Yet if the divine Word of God could become one of us by taking on our human nature with the cooperation of a young woman in Nazareth, God can surely touch our lives.*
